



COMMUNICATION WITH THE EUYO DURING OUR TRANSITIONAL PERIOD

The European Union Youth Orchestra (EUYO) is closing its London office on 4 July 2018 as part of the Orchestra's move of its legal and operational seat from the United Kingdom to Italy during 2018.

A new Orchestra Board based in Italy is now in operation and a EUYO legal seat has meanwhile been established in Rome. During the summer the Orchestra will be in residence in Grafenegg, and from the autumn a new EUYO office will be based at the Teatro Comunale Claudio Abbado di Ferrara. The Orchestra will also have the use of rehearsal spaces in Rome and meeting spaces in Brussels.

During the transition period for this move, the EUYO's daily operations and projects schedule will continue as normal. Regarding our major methods of communication:
